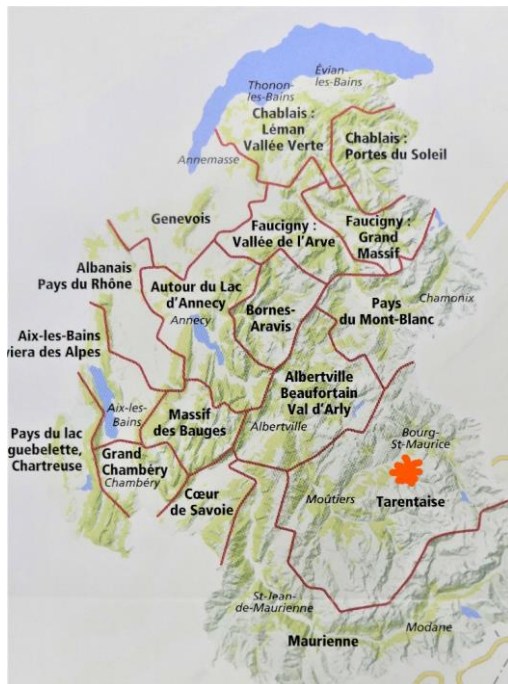

Peisey-Vallandry, at the gate of the Vanoise national Park

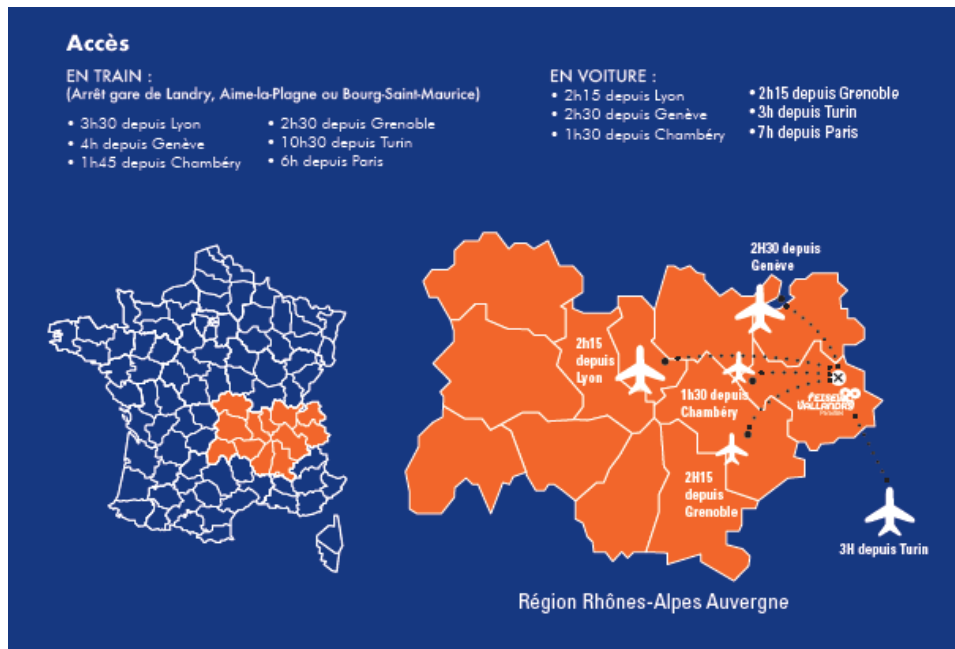


Two-thirds of the territory is included in the Vanoise National Park, the oldest French park, whose emblem is the Alpine ibex.



For more than 50 years in Peisey-Vallandry, nature protection has been taken into account in all developments.

Access : Train TGV direct from Paris and Lyon,
Thalys direct from Brussels, Eurostar direct from London !
2h30 from Lyon or Geneva airports. Service by bus, taxis.



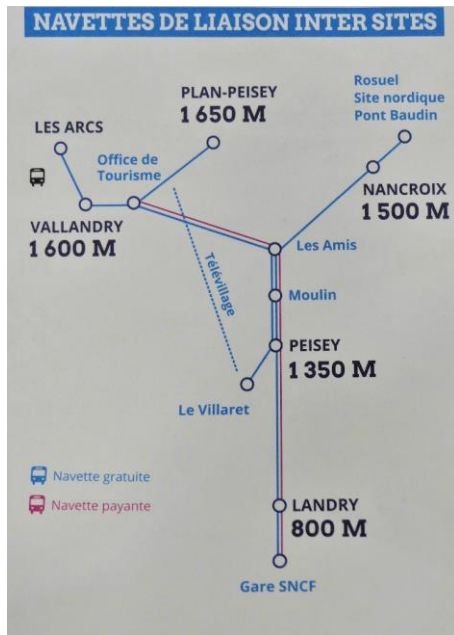
Peisey-Vallandry is a valley that stretches from the landscape of orchards on the banks of the Isère river at 800 m up to 3779 m above sea level, at the top of Mont-Pourri.

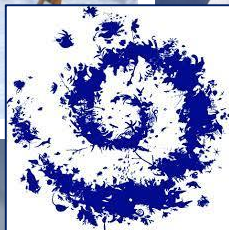

2.8 Ecology : Peisey-Vallandry's Commitments :

In addition to the active protection of natural areas :



Renewable energy: our valley produces more electricity than it consumes (Hydroelectricity, Chevril dam in Tignes)



Municipalities :

- start of the installation of charging stations for electric cars.
- burial of the electricity grid, investment in less costly street lighting that takes into account the needs of nocturnal fauna.



New : ski lifts

- the new Vallandry gondola : rainwater recovery, photovoltaic panels, reuse of heat produced by motors. . .
- Installation of bird protection modules on pida cables and TV cables.

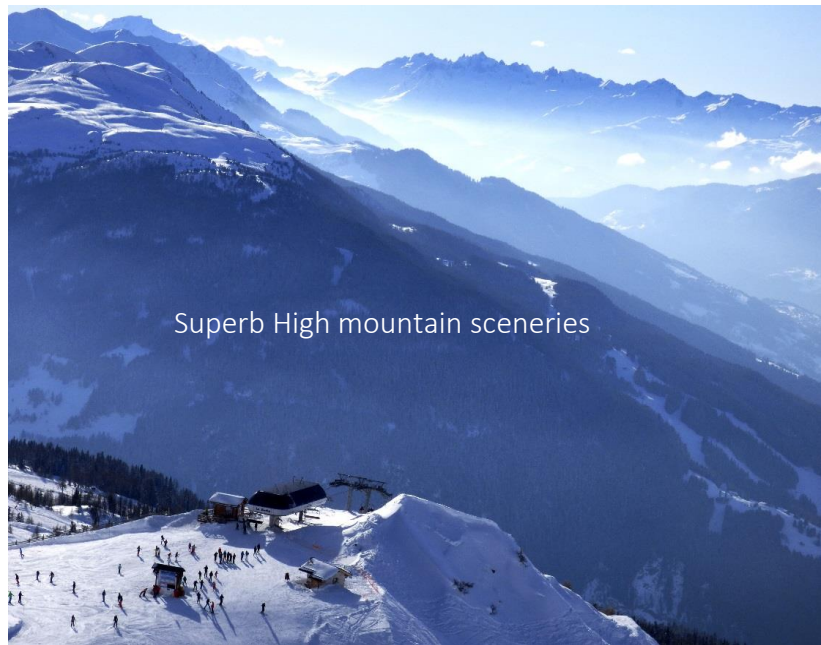

Snow coverage :

- 36 % of the ski area higher than 2000 m altitude.
- 50 % of the ski area is between 1500 and 2200 m altitude.
- snowmaking :
174 ha snow coverage by 594 snow cannons !

New : high-altitude gardens, accessible by cable car.
